As our population continues to grow, we will build more housing and provide better diversification in the type of housing available. In doing this, we will provide opportunities for Nunavummiut to learn new skills

and be gainfully employed while addressing one of our most important needs.”

The Nunavut Housing Corporation will continue to deliver and maintain social housing and expand housing options using its \$168 million Operations & Maintenance budget and \$120 million in capital funding. Beyond social housing, the Corporation also delivers a range of housing programs, including construction of government staff housing and

programs designed to increase home ownership by residents.

With a clear mandate and finances in place, NHC requires a dynamic leader to inspire and grow the team to develop progressive housing programs and to build, maintain and manage a broad range of properties and structures across a vast geographic territory.



## Deputy Minister, Community and Government Services

An opportunity has arisen for an executive leader with significant capital project experience to further build the infrastructure of Canada's newest territory.

Territorial infrastructure initiatives, supplemented by economic stimulus programs announced by the Government of Canada, have combined to present the opportunity to deliver \$150 million in capital
