

# Executive Director

The Nunavik Marine Region Wildlife Board (NMRWB) was established as the main instrument of wildlife management and main regulator of access to wildlife under the recent Nunavik Inuit Land Claims Agreement. This Agreement covers the offshore area surrounding the Province of Quebec known as the Nunavik Marine Region. The NMRWB is comprised of seven members: three appointed by Makivik Corporation (the Inuit entity); two appointed by the Federal Government; one appointed by the Government of Nunavut; and a Chairperson.

The NMRWB is seeking an Executive Director. This is a new position. The primary responsibilities associated with this position are:

- Working with the NMRWB to staff the office
- Managing the day-to-day operations of the NMRWB office, budget and staff
- Regularly evaluate NMRWB operations and prepare reports
- Represent the NMRWB with co-management partners, government and the public

The ideal candidate possesses knowledge of Nunavik and wildlife species in the Nunavik Marine Region, land claims agreements and management regimes; project and human resource management skills; and experience in cross-cultural settings.

Applicants should possess a university degree with specialization in business administration, wildlife management or equivalent. Experience will be taken in to consideration.

Applicants must be fluent in English and have a working knowledge of French. Competency in Inuktitut would be an asset.

The position is located in Inukjuak, Nunavik. Assistance for relocation is available. Housing is available at a subsidized rate. Starting salary is in the \$95,000 range plus a competitive benefits package.
